Football Game Notes: Dacotah Bank DAC Bowl pairings set for Sunday, Trojans look to win two straight games

TROJAN FOOTBALL

DACOTAH BANK DAC BOWL: The Dakota State University football team will travel to Fargo, N.D. for their final game of the season on Sunday. The Trojans will attempt for their second straight victory as they face Mayville State for the second time this season. DSU defeated the Comets last Saturday at the Trojan Field, 42-7. The game will be held at the FargoDome at 9:00 a.m.

Tickets to the Dacotah Bank DAC Bowl are available at the DSU Athletics' main office. Advanced tickets are \$15 for adults and \$5 for children. LAST SATURDAY: The Trojans won their first game of the season as they defeated Mayville State at the Trojan Field, 42-7. No. 16 Dickinson State clinched at least a share of DAC Conference title as they defeated No. 21 Minot State in a battle of DAC's undefeated teams 28-13; Black Hills State shut down South Dakota School of Mines, 26-0 and Jamestown won their fifth straight game as they defeated Valley City State, 38-19.

MAYVILLE STATE-DAKOTA STATE'S LAST MEETING: Dakota State trailed 7-6 at halftime, but racked up 36 second half points to rout Mayville State 42-7 last Saturday at the Trojan Field. It was the Trojans' first DAC conference win and snapped their seven-game losing streak. Mayville State remained winless in seven conference games and suffered their seventh straight defeat.

Paul Bagala was 25-for-50 with 308 yards and four touchdown passes and no interceptions for DSU. Stacey Berg had four receptions for 87 yards and a touchdown. Weston Daus added seven catches for 52 yards and two touchdowns. Drew Allen rushed 17 times for 123 yards with two touchdowns for the Trojans.

Dakota State limited Mayville State's Tanner Carpenter to 13-for-35 with 110 yards and three interceptions. Kevin Irby, Jr. had one catch for 29 yards. Victor Redd added two receptions for 24 yards. Mitchel Ford was limited to nine rushes for 32 yards for the Comets.

The Trojans recorded 22 first downs compared to the Comets' 13. DSU out-gained Mayville State 438-192.

DSU was splendid on defense and forced the Comets to six turnovers in the game – three by interceptions, two by fumbles and one on downs. Joe Monize, Joe Whealy and Eric Liles each recorded an interception for the Trojans. Brandon Stahl and Dana Felderman each had 10 tackles. Bryce Logan and Felderman each recorded a fumble recover. Overall as a team, the Trojans had 14.0 tackles for loss of 35.0 yards.

Clifton Krotz and Thomas Sly each had nine tackles for Mayville State.
