NAIA Postseason Play: In 1992, the Trojans made their first ever trip to the NAIA National Tournament held in Stephenville, Texas. The Trojans defeated Edgewood (Wis.) in the first round and went on to upset #1 seed King College (Tenn.), 92-79 in the quarterfinals. In the "Elite Eight" round, the Trojans defeated William Jewell (Mo.) to make a berth to the NAIA "Final Four". Northwestern (IA) ended Trojans' run at the national tournament in the "Final Four" by the score of 91-68.

TROJANS FACE BLUE HAWKS AND BEAVERS ON ROAD THIS WEEKEND: The Trojan men's basketball team will take a trip to North Dakota this weekend for a pair of DAC Conference games.

Dakota State will face Dickinson State on Friday in Dickinson, N.D. Tip-off is slated at 8:30 p.m. (CT)/7:30 p.m. (MT). On Saturday evening, the Trojans will visit Minot State in Minot, N.D. at 6 p.m.

FOR THE RECORD: Dakota State is currently on a two-game winning streak. The Trojans are 9-12 overall and 3-5 in the DAC Conference. Dakota State had surpassed their wins total from last year. Dickinson State is 10-12 overall and 5-4 in the DAC. Minot State is 16-7 and 5-4 in the DAC.

Dakota State is in a two-way tie for sixth place with South Dakota School of Mines in the DAC standings. Minot State and Dickinson State are tied for 4th place with a 5-4 conference record.



2009-10 NAIA MEN'S BASKETBALL DIVISION II 'TOP 25' RANKINGS: One DAC school is ranked in the latest NAIA Men's Basketball Division II 'Top 25' rankings.

Minot State dropped seven spots to No. 23 after suffering two road losses.

Black Hills State and Jamestown received votes to the national poll.

A new poll will be released on Feb 8st.

LAST WEEKEND: Dakota State began their second half of the DAC conference play at Mayville State on Jan. 28th. The Trojans suffered a 59-57 heartbreaking loss to the Comets. DSU rebounded with two straight wins at home on Jan. 30th and Feb. 2nd. The Trojans defeated Mount Marty on Derek Kreutzfeldt's 3-pointer at the buzzer, 59-58. DSU defeated Morningside 65-55.

Dickinson State defeated Valley City State in Valley City, N.D. on Jan. 29th. The Blue Hawks held a 42-33 halftime advantage and defeated the Vikings 81-70. Dickinson State suffered a 67-61 road loss to Jamestown.

Minot State lost twice on the road last weekend. Jamestown had a one-point halftime lead (32-31) and went on to defeat the Beavers 88-80. Valley City State rallied from 45-37 halftime deficit to defeat Minot State 83-74.

Head Coach Gary Garner

Gary Garner is entering his first year as Dakota State men's basketball head coach.



"Gary's prior experience as a Division I and II coach at highly successful collegiate programs will be invaluable as he readies to lead our team," said Gene Wockenfuss, DSU Athletic Director. "He brings a tremendous amount of basketball experience and knowledge to Dakota State."

Garner collegiate experience is primarily on the Division I and II levels. For the past two years, he has served as the assistant coach for Iowa Energy, a team with the NBA Development League. He served as head basketball coach at Southeast Missouri State University from 1997-2006. From 1991-1997, he held the men's team at Fort Hays State University. His 1995-1996 team won the NCAA Division II Tournament, capping a perfect 34-0 season. That same year Garner was named the NCAA II Bulletin National Coach of the Year and the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference of the Year.

Garner also served stints as head coach at Drake University and Missouri Southern University. He has been an assistant at the University of Missouri and Tulsa University.

His coaching career has included multiple appearances at the NCAA Division II Tournament. His Southeast Missouri State team reached the NCAA Division I Tournament in 2000. Garner reached his 300 collegiate win in 2000. His record of 63-2 was the best among collegiate coaches during 1995-1997.

Garner and his wife Barb moved from Des Moines to Madison. "I am really excited about the opportunity to be the Head Basketball Coach at Dakota State University and to begin our journey toward building a championship program," said Garner. "I look forward to bringing student-athletes to Dakota State that will represent the students, faculty, alumni and community in a manner that they can be proud of."

Assistant Coach



Matthew Garner is in his first year as Assistant Men's Basketball Coach. Prior coming to Dakota State University, he was the assistant men's basketball coach for the University of Denver. Garner had coaching experiences with DeSmet High School in St. Louis, Mo. and Southeast

Missouri State University.

Garner played college basketball at Fort Hays State University. He graduated with his bachelor's degree from Southeast Missouri State University.

Besides coaching, Garner is the Resident Director for the Higbie Hall at Dakota State University.

Game Notes

DAKOTA STATE-DICKINSON STATE MATCHUP: Dickinson State handed Dakota State its first DAC Conference loss on Jan. 9th in Madison, S.D. The Blue Hawks went 22-for-25 at the free-throw line compared to the Trojans' 5-for-12. Dickinson State closed the game with a 17-9 run to defeat the Trojans 74-67 at the DSU Fieldhouse.

Santino Clay leads the Trojans in scoring with 11.3 points per game. He shoots 43.4 percent from the field. In addition, he leads the team in total steals with 29 (1.6 average). Bryce Snyder records 142 total rebounds this season (6.8 average). Derek Kreutzfeldt leads the team in total assists with 35 (1.7 average). Eric Bauder records 18 blocked shots this season (0.9 average). As a team, Dakota State ranks 18th in the nation in scoring defense per game (66.8), 20th in field goal percentage (41.1) and 46th in total rebound margin (+3.4).

Nathan Lebsack leads the Blue Hawks in scoring with an average of 16.2 points per game. He records 28 total steals this season. Nathan Lebsack ranks 23rd in the nation in free throw percentage (82.8). Joshua Henry averages 6.9 rebounds per game. Ben Lebsack leads the team in total assists with 74. As a team, Dickinson State ranks first in total rebound defense (28.1), 35th in total rebound margin (+4.3), 42nd in field goal percentage (46.2) and 45th in scoring defense (70.6).

DAKOTA STATE-MINOT STATE MATCHUP: In both teams' first meeting on Jan. 8th in Madison, S.D., the Trojans upset then-No. 11 Minot State, 76-75.

The Trojans held the Beavers to 1-for-10 from the field in the first seven minutes of the game. DSU raced to a 13-3 opening lead with 12:14 left in the first half. Minot State would respond with a 17-7 run to knot the game at 20 with 8:54 to go before intermission. The Trojans grabbed a 42-36 halftime lead.

With the game tied at 75 with 4.4 seconds to go, Minot State's Kenneth McCoy drew a foul on Bryce Snyder to set-up a double-bonus free throw situation for the Trojans. Snyder made the first one and missed the second one. Minot State's Jason West missed a 3-pointer as time expired.

Nick Turner leads Minot State with 19.6 points per game. He ranks 21st in the nation in points per game. Shaun Johnson averages 8.3 rebounds per game and ranks first in the nation in field goal percentage (70.3). West leads the team in assists with 86. Mister Carney records 72 total steals this season. As a team, Minot State ranks 1st in steals per game (12.7), 3rd in turnover margin (+5.6), 7th in scoring offense per game (88.3) and 9th in total blocks (96).
