#### TROJANS RETURN TO ACTION

**THIS WEEK:** The Dakota State University women's basketball team will return back to action this week. The Trojans will be facing three teams from the Great Plains Athletic Conference.

University of Sioux Falls will be hosting the Holiday Inn Classic on Tuesday and Wednesday. Jamestown, Dakota Wesleyan and Dakota State will be part of the four-team classic. The Trojans will face DWU on Tuesday night at 6 p.m. and host team University of Sioux Falls on Wednesday at 4 p.m. All games will be held at the Stewart Center in Sioux Falls, S.D.

On Saturday, Jan. 2nd, 2010, the Trojans will welcome No. 2 Hastings College at the DSU Fieldhouse at 6 p.m. Hastings is coached by former longtime DSU women's basketball head coach Jeff Dittman. It will mark his first time returning to the DSU Fieldhouse.

**FOR THE RECORD:** Dakota State is 4-6 overall and 1-0 in the DAC Conference. Dakota Wesleyan is 5-10 overall. The Cougars is riding a five-game winning streak and is 10-5 on the season. Hastings is currently on a 10-game winning streak and is 14-2 overall.

**LAST TIME:** The last time Trojans defeated a top-ten team at the DSU Fieldhouse is on Jan. 10, 2009. DSU defeated No. 4 Jamestown in a DAC Conference game 70-68.

**TROJANS RETURN TO DAC CONFERENCE PLAY:** The Trojans will return to DAC Conference play on weekend of Jan. 8-9. DSU will host No. 13 Minot State on Jan. 8 at 5:30 p.m. On Saturday, Jan. 9th, the Trojans will host Dickinson State at 4 p.m. All games will be held at the DSU Fieldhouse.

**Head Coach Joe Reints**

Joe Reints is in his second year with the Trojan women's basketball program. He comes to Dakota State University from Lambuth University in Jackson, Tenn., where he served as head coach of the Lady Eagles, an NAIA Division I school, for three years. The Lady Eagles earned the 2007 NAIA Division I National Championship. Coach Reints' career record at Lambuth University was 69-33 and his team maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.03.



From 2003-2005, Reints served as Assistant Women's Basketball Coach for Texas State University. He has additional coaching experience with Mount Marty College and Northern State University. Reints graduated from South Dakota State University with a Bachelor of Science in History and from Northern State University with a Master's in Health, Physical Education, and Coaching.

Reints is originally from Willow Lake, S.D. In addition to his coaching duties, Reints serves as assistant to the athletic director.

**Troy Erslund** is entering his second season on Coach Reints' staff as the assistant women's basketball coach. Prior coming to Dakota State University, Erslund served as an assistant at Luther College (Decorah, Iowa), Rose Hulman Institute of Technology (Terre Haute, Ind.) and was a student assistant manager at the University of Wyoming.

In addition, he began his coaching career on the junior and senior high school levels in Waterloo, Iowa.

Erslund is involved heavily in every aspect of the women's basketball program and his primary focuses are recruiting, academic supervision and coordinating/scheduling summer team camps. He has over ten years of experience coaching and teaching the game of basketball on all levels and has worked summer camps across the country, including Snow Valley Basketball School in Iowa, University of Tennessee Lady Vols, South Dakota State University, Drake University, University of Wyoming and Northern State University.

Erslund, a graduate of Columbus High School in Waterloo, Iowa, earned his bachelor's degree in Recreation and Sports Management and his master's degree in Physical Education/Coaching from Indiana State University. In his personal time, he enjoys cheering on the Boston Celtics and Chicago Bears, reading, playing fantasy football/basketball and spending time with his family and friends.

In addition to coaching responsibilities, Erslund serves as the Resident Director of the Zimmerman Hall at Dakota State University.

**Game Notes**

**DAKOTA STATE-DAKOTA WESLEYAN MATCHUP:** Dakota Wesleyan won the first meeting on Nov. 10th at the Corn Palace in Mitchell, S.D. DWU used an advantage at the free-throw line to defeat the Trojans 84-79.

The Tigers held a one-point lead at halftime, 37-36. Both teams traded leads in the second half before the Tigers went on an 8-2 run to make it 75-68 with 2:27 left in regulation. The Trojans rallied back to tie the game at 77-77 with 42 seconds. A three-pointer and free throws down the stretch by DWU secured the win. The Tigers went 23-for-29 at the free-throw line compared to the Trojans' 0-for-1.

Ellesse Washington leads DSU in scoring and total steals. She averages 11.2 points and 1.1 steals per game. Donna Lavea averages 6.9 rebounds and ranks 23rd in the nation in offensive rebounds per game (3.6). She also records 0.9 blocks per game. Katie Bourk ranks 44th in the nation in total assists with 39. Alyssa Kirk ranks 26th in the nation in 3-point field made per game (2.5).

Allison Johnson leads the Tigers in three different categories. She averages 12.9 points, 2.7 assists and 1.5 steals per game. She ranks 39th in the nation in free-throw percentage (80.4). Maggie Malloy records 96 total rebounds (6.4 average). Marie Olson ranks 46th in the nation in blocked shots with 14.

**DAKOTA STATE-UNIVERSITY OF SIOUX FALLS MATCHUP:** Dakota State defeated then No. 15 University of Sioux Falls on Trojans' home court on Nov. 3rd in Madison. The Trojans jumped to a 36-26 halftime lead with a 54.5 percent first-half shooting performance and held on for a 67-48 win.

The Trojans had a 44-27 rebounding edge over USF. DSU shot 46.2 percent from the field compared to the Cougars' 34.5. The Trojans made seven 3-pointers to USF's three.

Becky Christofferson leads USF in scoring with 11.4 points per game. Elizabeth Hildreth records 84 total rebounds (6.5 average) and eight blocked shots. Holli Aggen averages 2.2 assists per game for the Cougars. Dominique Schuler have 23 total steals this season (1.8 average).





**HASTINGS-DAKOTA STATE MATCHUP:** Hastings defeated the Trojans in the second day of the Morningside Classic on Nov. 7th. The Broncos raced to an 18-8 lead in opening minutes of the game. Hastings went on and control the lead through out the game and defeated the Trojans 87-63.

Hastings raced to a 53-23 halftime lead and controlled the second half. The Trojans outscored the Broncos 40-34 in the second half.

The Broncos shot 50 percent from the field compared to the Trojans' 37.5 percent. Hastings was 13-for-26 from the three-point arc compared to the Trojans' 5-for-18. Hastings won the rebounding battle with 41 rebounds to DSU's 30.

Hastings is led by NAIA All-American Lindsay Ducey. She averages 19.3 points, 8.9 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game. Ducey ranks sixth in the nation in total scoring (308) and 12th in total rebounds (142). Kim Faimon leads the team with 3.4 assists and 2.9 steals per game. She ranks ninth in the nation in total steals (47). As a team, the Broncos ranks first in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (43.8).
