NAIA Postseason Play: In 1992, the Trojans made their first ever trip to the NAIA National Tournament held in Stephenville, Texas. The Trojans defeated Edgewood (Wis.) in the first round and went on to upset #1 seed King College (Tenn.), 92-79 in the quarterfinals. In the "Elite Eight" round, the Trojans defeated William Jewell (Mo.) to make a berth to the NAIA "Final Four". Northwestern (IA) ended Trojans' run at the national tournament in the "Final Four" by the score of 91-68.

UPCOMING TROJAN MEN'S

BASKETBALL GAMES: The Dakota State University men's basketball team return back to action this week after taking a holiday break. The Trojans will welcome NCAA Division II Wayne State on Wednesday, Dec. 30th at the DSU Fieldhouse. Tip-off is slated at 7 p.m.

On Monday, Jan. 4th, 2010, the Trojans will travel to Sioux City, Iowa to take on Morningside College. The game will be held at the RVSC/Allee Gym at 7:30 p.m.

FOR THE RECORD: Dakota State is 5-5 overall and 1-0 in the DAC Conference. Wayne State defeated Morningside 79-74 on Dec. 19th to raise Wildcat's overall record to 3-6. Morningside is 7-6 on the season.

TROJANS RETURN TO DAC CONFERENCE PLAY NEXT WEEKEND:

The Trojans will return to DAC Conference play on the weekend of Jan. 8-9. DSU will host No. 11 Minot State on Jan. 8 at 7:30 p.m. On Saturday, Jan. 9, the Trojans will host Dickinson State at 6 p.m. All games will be held at the DSU Fieldhouse.

TROJANS PLAY WELL IN EXHIBITION GAME WITH NCAA DIVISION II

AUGUSTANA (S.D.): The Trojans faced the Vikings on Dec. 19 in DSU's final exhibition game of the season at the Elmen Center. The Vikings shot 9-for-13 from the 3-point line in the first-half for a 56-31 halftime lead and defeated the Trojans 80-64.

DSU limited the Vikings to 24 points in the second half. The Trojans scored 33 points in the second half. The Vikings shot 52.5 percent (32-for-61) compared to the Trojans 40.9 percent (27-for-66).

DSU SUFFERED HOME LOSS TO

SAINTS: The Trojans dropped back to .500 for the season as they suffered a home loss to Ashford (Iowa) 80-70 on Dec. 20.

The first-half featured eight ties. The Saints used their advantage at the free-throw line, going 11-for-11 compared to the Trojans' 3-for-7. The Saints held a 44-38 halftime lead.

DSU got within one point (50-49) with 14:36 left in the second-half, but the Saints continued to hold their lead between four and eight points through out the second-half.

The Saints were 24-for-25 at the free-throw line compared to the Trojans' 4-for-8.

Head Coach Gary Garner

Gary Garner is entering his first year as Dakota State men's basketball head coach.



"Gary's prior experience as a Division I and II coach at highly successful collegiate programs will be invaluable as he readies to lead our team," said Gene Wockenfuss, DSU Athletic Director. "He brings a tremendous amount of basketball experience and knowledge to Dakota State."

Garner collegiate experience is primarily on the Division I and II levels. For the past two years, he has served as the assistant coach for Iowa Energy, a team with the NBA Development League. He served as head basketball coach at Southeast Missouri State University from 1997-2006. From 1991-1997, he held the men's team at Fort Hays State University. His 1995-1996 team won the NCAA Division II Tournament, capping a perfect 34-0 season. That same year Garner was named the NCAA II Bulletin National Coach of the Year and the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference of the Year.

Garner also served stints as head coach at Drake University and Missouri Southern University. He has been an assistant at the University of Missouri and Tulsa University.

His coaching career has included multiple appearances at the NCAA Division II Tournament. His Southeast Missouri State team reached the NCAA Division I Tournament in 2000. Garner reached his 300 collegiate win in 2000. His record of 63-2 was the best among collegiate coaches during 1995-1997.

Garner and his wife Barb moved from Des Moines to Madison. "I am really excited about the opportunity to be the Head Basketball Coach at Dakota State University and to begin our journey toward building a championship program," said Garner. "I look forward to bringing student-athletes to Dakota State that will represent the students, faculty, alumni and community in a manner that they can be proud of."

Game Notes

WAYNE STATE-DAKOTA STATE MATCHUP: This will be the fifth time in the history between Wayne State and Dakota State faced each other. The Wildcats currently holds a 4-0 series lead.

Santino Clay leads the Trojans in scoring and steals. He averages 15.4 points per game and records a total of 20 steals this season. Clay ranks 39th in the nation in total steals and 41st in 3-point field goal percentage (43.6). Bryce Snyder averages 8.3 rebounds for the Trojans. He ranks 38th in the nation in total rebounds per game. Jason DeZeeuw leads the team in assists with 26 (2.6 assists per game). He ranks 49th in the nation in free-throw percentage (80.6). Eric Bauder records 12 blocked shots this season (1.3 blocks per game). As a team, the Trojans are 4th in the nation in field goal percentage defense (37.6), 14th in defense rebounds per game (28.5), 29th in total rebounds margin (+6.3) and 35th in scoring defense (68.2).

For Wayne State, Brad Starken leads the team in scoring with 13.1 points per game. Amry Shelby and Brett Spiker each average 12.1 points per game. Spiker averages 7.6 rebounds per game. Jason Jensen records 26 assists for the Wildcats. Brian Metz leads the team in blocked shots with five. As a team, the Wildcats averages 48.2 percent from the field and 32.3 rebounds per game.

DAKOTA STATE-MORNINGSIDE MATCHUP: Morningside took both meetings from the Trojans last season, both by 20 points (88-68 in Madison, S.D. and 80-60 in Sioux City, Iowa). The Trojans and Mustangs will be meet again for the second meeting in Madison on Feb. 2.




Mitch Carstens leads the team in scoring and total steals. He averages 15.2 points per game and records 37 total season. Carstens ranks 9th in the nation in steals per game (2.8). Garth Hamilton averages 6.4 rebounds per game and six blocked shots. Eddie Marrs leads the team in assists with an average of 2.9 per game. As a team, the Mustangs ranks 20th in the nation in total steals (134) and 30th in turnover margin (+2.5).
