DSU TRAVELS TO NORTH

DAKOTA THIS WEEKEND: The Dakota State University women's basketball team will travel to North Dakota this weekend for a pair of DAC conference games.

The Trojans will visit Dickinson State in Dickinson, N.D. on Friday at 6:30 p.m. (CT)/5:30 p.m. (MT). On Saturday, DSU will play at Minot State in Minot, N.D. at 4 p.m.

NAIA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL DIVISION II 'TOP 25' RANKINGS:

Three DAC schools are ranked in the seventh edition of the NAIA Women's Basketball Division II "Top 25" rankings.

Jamestown dropped one spot to No. 7 after going 1-1 last weekend. Black Hills State remained at to No. 10. Jamestown will visit Black Hills State in a battle of NAIA's "Top Ten" teams.

Valley City State and Dickinson State received votes to the national poll.

A new poll will be released on Feb. 8th.

FOR THE RECORD: Dakota State is 8-12 overall and 3-5 in the DAC Conference. Dickinson State is on a four-game losing streak and is 12-10 overall and 4-5 in the DAC. Minot State is 16-6 and 5-4 in the DAC.

The Trojans are in a two-way tie for sixth place with SD School of Mines in the DAC Standings. Dickinson State is fifth. Minot State and Valley City State are tied for third place in the DAC.

LAVEA TABBED AS DAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Lavea scored 44 points (22.0 per game), grabbed 16 rebounds (8.0 per game) and added six assists (3.0 per game) and a blocked shot (0.5 per game) as the Trojans split a pair of conference games. This is her second time this season that she had received this honor.

For the week, Lavea was 17-of-27 from the field and 10-of-14 from the free throw line.

LAST WEEKEND: The Trojans went to Mayville State last Thursday to begin the DAC's second-half schedule play. DSU lost 84-76 at the Lewy Lee Fieldhouse.

Dickinson State suffered losses at Valley City State and Jamestown. The Blue Hawks held a 34-28 halftime advantage and lost by two points, 55-53 last Friday. Last Saturday, Dickinson State faced Jamestown and went in overtime. The Jimmies outscored the Blue Hawks 10-6 in overtime for Jamestown's 63-59 victory.

Minot State defeated Jamestown 70-55 in Jamestown, N.D. on Jan. 29th. The Beavers raced to 36-25 halftime lead and held on to win. On Jan. 30th, Minot State suffered a road loss to Valley City State. The Vikings outscored the Beavers 32-23 in the second half for Vikings' 65-56 victory.

Head Coach Joe Reints

Joe Reints is in his second year with the Trojan women's basketball program. He comes to Dakota State University from Lambuth University in Jackson, Tenn., where he served as head coach of the Lady Eagles, an NAIA Division I school, for three years. The Lady Eagles earned the 2007 NAIA Division I National Championship. Coach Reints' career record at Lambuth University was 69-33 and his team maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.03.



From 2003-2005, Reints served as Assistant Women's Basketball Coach for Texas State University. He has additional coaching experience with Mount Marty College and Northern State University. Reints graduated from South Dakota State University with a Bachelor of Science in History and from Northern State University with a Master's in Health, Physical Education, and Coaching.

Reints is originally from Willow Lake, S.D. In addition to his coaching duties, Reints serves as assistant to the athletic director.

Assistant Coach



Troy Erslund is entering his second season on Coach Reints' staff as the assistant women's basketball coach. Prior coming to Dakota State University, Erslund served as an assistant at Luther College (Decorah, Iowa), Rose Hulman Institute of Technology (Terre Haute, Ind.) and was a student assistant manager at the University of Wyoming.

In addition, he began his coaching career on the junior and senior high school levels in Waterloo, Iowa.

Erslund is involved heavily in every aspect of the women's basketball program and his primary focuses are recruiting, academic supervision and coordinating/scheduling summer team camps. He has over ten years of experience coaching and teaching the game of basketball on all levels and has worked summer camps across the country, including Snow Valley Basketball School in Iowa, University of Tennessee Lady Vols, South Dakota State University, Drake University, University of Wyoming and Northern State University.

Erslund, a graduate of Columbus High School in Waterloo, Iowa, earned his bachelor's degree in Recreation and Sports Management and his master's degree in Physical Education/Coaching from Indiana State University. In his personal time, he enjoys cheering on the Boston Celtics and Chicago Bears, reading, playing fantasy football/basketball and spending time with his family and friends.

In addition to coaching responsibilities, Erslund serves as the Resident Director of the Zimmerman Hall at Dakota State University.

Game Notes

DAKOTA STATE-DICKINSON STATE MATCHUP: Dakota State and Dickinson State met on Jan. 9th in Madison, S.D. The Blue Hawks came away with a 56-54 thrilling win over the Trojans.

The Trojans scored six straight points to open the game. The Trojans held the Blue Hawks to no field goals in the first 3:53 of the game. Dickinson State rallied back and took a 30-27 halftime advantage.

The Blue Hawks extended with a 13-4 run to grab the largest lead at 43-31 with 15:46 left in the game. The Trojans responded with a 21-5 run to overtake a 52-48 lead with 5:57 left in regulation. The Blue Hawks came back and tie the game at 52 and 54. Jennifer Marquez made two free-throws for Dickinson State's 56-54 with 1:58 left.

Donna Lavea leads the Trojans in three different categories. She averages 13.3 points per game and shoots 54.9 percent from the field (11th in the nation). Lavea leads the team in rebounds with 7.5 average. She ranks 30th in the nation in total blocks with 30 (1.5 average). Katie Bourk ranks 34th in the nation in assists per game (4.1). Elisse Washington leads the team in steals with 27 (1.4 average). Alyssa Kirk ranks 25th in the nation in 3-point field goal made per game (2.4). As a team, Dakota State ranks 32nd in the nation in 3-point field goal made per game (7.0), 33rd in field goal percentage (42.1) and 45th in total 3-point field goals made (140).

Kia Herbel averages 18.1 points per game for Dickinson State. She shoots 71.2 percent from the field and ranks first in the nation in field goal percentage. Herbel averages 10.9 rebounds per game and ranks ninth in the nation in total rebounds (239). She leads the team in blocked shots with 21. Teryl Norton records 51 assists (2.3).

Amber Adams leads the game in steals with 26. As a team, Dickinson State ranks 20th in free throw percentage (73.1), 37th in 3-point field goal percentage (33.4) and 37th in field goal percentage (41.7).

DAKOTA STATE-MINOT STATE MATCHUP: Dakota State and Minot State met the first meeting in Madison, S.D. on Jan. 8th. The Trojans could not hold their lead in the second-half as the Beavers rallied for 68-66 DAC conference win.

With DSU holding a 18-15 lead with 6:46 left before intermission, the Trojans went on a 15-8 run to take a 33-23 halftime lead. The Beavers went on a 27-17 second-half run to tie the game at 50 with 11:04 left in the game. The teams alternated the lead in the closing minutes. The game was tied at 62 with 1:59 and the Beavers made key free throws by Ari Hendrix and MacKenzie Mack. Minot State held a 67-64 lead with eight seconds to go. Bourk made a layup to cut the deficit to 67-66 with 1.4 seconds, but it wasn't enough as DSU could not secure a win.

Mack leads the team in scoring with an average of 15.5 points per game for Minot State. She ranks 21st in the nation in field goal percentage (50.4). Mack averages 8.4 rebounds per game. Hendrix records 100 assists and 54 steals. She ranks 14th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (43.0). As a team, Minot State ranks fifth in the nation in assist/turnover ratio (0.989), 16th in assists per game (15.6), 22nd in total assists (344) and 28th in field goal percentage (42.3).
