**WEEKEND GAMES:** The Dakota State University women's basketball team will play their final home weekend games at the DSU Fieldhouse.

On Friday night (Elite1 Sanford Game Sponsor Night and Hawaiian Night), the Trojans will host No. 6 Black Hills State at 5:30 p.m. On Saturday, DSU will welcome South Dakota School of Mines at 4 p.m. as part of DSU Faculty/Staff recognition night.

#### NAIA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL DIVISION II 'TOP 25' RANKINGS:

Three DAC schools are ranked in the eighth edition of the NAIA Women's Basketball Division II "Top 25" rankings.

Black Hills State moved up four spots to No. 6. The Yellow Jackets are currently on an eight-game winning streak. Jamestown dropped to No. 10. Minot State remained at No. 13.

Dickinson State received votes to the national poll.

A new poll will be released on Feb. 15th.

#### PARENTS/SENIORS NIGHT:

Parents/Seniors night will be held on Tuesday, Feb. 16th in Trojan's final home game of the season versus Trinity Bible (6 p.m.).

**FOR THE RECORD:** Dakota State is 8-14 overall and 3-7 in the DAC Conference. Black Hills State is 19-5 overall and 8-2 in the DAC. SD School of Mines's overall record is 11-13 and 4-6 in the conference.

The Trojans are seventh in the DAC standings. The Yellow Jackets is first in the DAC. SD School of Mines is sixth.

**LAST WEEKEND:** The Trojans suffered two defeats in North Dakota. Dakota State lost to Dickinson State in overtime 73-64 on Feb. 5th. Minot State defeated the Trojans 79-60 on Feb. 6th.

Black Hills State won the battle of NAIA "Top Ten" teams on Feb. 5th in Spearfish, S.D. The Yellow Jackets defeated Jamestown 67-60. BHSU continued their winning streak to eight games as they defeated Valley City State 80-57 on Feb. 6th.

South Dakota School of Mines recorded one win and one loss last weekend in Rapid City, S.D. The Hardrockers defeated Valley City State 71-61 on Feb. 5th. SD School of Mines suffered an overtime loss to nationally-ranked Jamestown 80-74 on Feb. 6th.

**Head Coach Joe Reints**

Joe Reints is in his second year with the Trojan women's basketball program. He comes to Dakota State University from Lambuth University in Jackson, Tenn., where he served as head coach of the Lady Eagles, an NAIA Division I school, for three years. The Lady Eagles earned the 2007 NAIA Division I National Championship. Coach Reints' career record at Lambuth University was 69-33 and his team maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.03.



From 2003-2005, Reints served as Assistant Women's Basketball Coach for Texas State University. He has additional coaching experience with Mount Marty College and Northern State University. Reints graduated from South Dakota State University with a Bachelor of Science in History and from Northern State University with a Master's in Health, Physical Education, and Coaching.

Reints is originally from Willow Lake, S.D. In addition to his coaching duties, Reints serves as assistant to the athletic director.

**Assistant Coach**



**Troy Erslund** is entering his second season on Coach Reints' staff as the assistant women's basketball coach. Prior coming to Dakota State University, Erslund served as an assistant at Luther College (Decorah, Iowa), Rose Hulman Institute of Technology (Terre Haute, Ind.) and was a student assistant manager at the University of Wyoming.

In addition, he began his coaching career on the junior and senior high school levels in Waterloo, Iowa.

Erslund is involved heavily in every aspect of the women's basketball program and his primary focuses are recruiting, academic supervision and coordinating/scheduling summer team camps. He has over ten years of experience coaching and teaching the game of basketball on all levels and has worked summer camps across the country, including Snow Valley Basketball School in Iowa, University of Tennessee Lady Vols, South Dakota State University, Drake University, University of Wyoming and Northern State University.

Erslund, a graduate of Columbus High School in Waterloo, Iowa, earned his bachelor's degree in Recreation and Sports Management and his master's degree in Physical Education/Coaching from Indiana State University. In his personal time, he enjoys cheering on the Boston Celtics and Chicago Bears, reading, playing fantasy football/basketball and spending time with his family and friends.

In addition to coaching responsibilities, Erslund serves as the Resident Director of the Zimmerman Hall at Dakota State University.

**Game Notes**

**BLACK HILLS STATE-DAKOTA STATE MATCHUP:** Black Hills State won the first meeting 79-54 this season from Dakota State in Spearfish on Jan. 16th. The Trojans had a brief 2-0 lead early in the game and the Yellow Jackets rallied with a 19-7 scoring surge for a 19-9 lead midway through the first half. Black Hills State shot 19-for-38 (50 percent) in the first half compared to the Trojans' 10-for-21 (47.6 percent) for Yellow Jackets' 47-29 halftime advantage.

DSU could not get any closer than 12 points (51-39) in the second half. The Yellow Jackets forced the Trojans 27 turnovers in the game and scored 31 points off turnovers. Black Hills State had 15 turnovers in the game.

Donna Lavea leads the Trojans in three different categories. She averages 12.6 points per game and shoots 52.5 percent from the field (13th in the nation). Lavea leads the team in rebounds with 7.4 average. She ranks 40th in the nation in total blocks with 30 (1.4 average). Katie Bourk ranks 43rd in the nation in assists per game (3.9). She ranks 11th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (42.7). Elisse Washington leads the team in steals with 31 (1.4 average). Alyssa Kirk ranks 21st in the nation in 3-point field goal made per game (2.4). As a team, Dakota State ranks 25th in the nation in 3-point field goal made per game (7.3), 38th in 3-point field goals made (161), 44th in field goal percentage (41.0) and 46th in 3-point field goal percentage (33.1).

Kia Herbel averages 18.1 points per game for Dickinson State. She shoots 71.2 percent from the field and ranks first in the nation in field goal percentage. Herbel averages 10.9 rebounds per game and ranks ninth in the nation in total rebounds (239). She leads the team in blocked shots with 21. Teryl Norton records 51 assists (2.3). Amber Adams leads the game in steals with 26. As a team, Dickinson State ranks 20th in free throw percentage (73.1), 37th in 3-point field goal percentage (33.4) and 37th in field goal percentage (41.7).

**SD SCHOOL OF MINES-DAKOTA STATE MATCHUP:** The Trojans overcame the Hardrockers' second-half surge as the Trojans won the first meeting 74-72 in Rapid City, S.D. on Jan. 15th.

The Trojans led 36-28 few minutes before intermission. SD School of Mines cut the deficit to 36-34 at halftime and continued their 15-0 run (span in the closing minutes of the first half and early second half) to overtake a 43-36 lead with under 18 minutes to go.

SD School of Mines held a 69-58 lead with 3:15 to go in the game. The Trojans took advantage of their own clutch shooting and SD Mines' turnovers where the Trojans used a 16-3 closing run to secure the victory.

Bethany Holyoak leads the Hardrockers in scoring with 17.5 points per game (24th in the nation). She ranks sixth in the nation in field goal percentage (58.9). Holyoak records 220 rebounds (9.2 average) and ranks 21st in the nation in total rebounds. She ranks 15th in the nation in total blocks (45). Shalane Hamp leads the team with 84 assists and 31 steals. As a team, SD School of Mines ranks 5th in the nation in defense rebounds per game (29.9), 15th in field goal percentage (43.6), 18th in 3-point field goal percentage (35.0) and 19th in total blocks (99).
