#### TROJANS PLAY FINAL KEY DAC WEEKEND GAMES IN NORTH DAKOTA:

The Dakota State University women's basketball team will play their final regular season games in North Dakota this weekend in a key DAC conference games.

The Trojans will visit Valley City State on Friday night. The game will be held in Valley City, N.D. at 5:30 p.m. On Saturday afternoon, DSU will play nationally-ranked Jamestown in Jamestown, N.D. at 4 p.m.

#### NAIA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL DIVISION II 'TOP 25' RANKINGS:

Three DAC schools are ranked in the ninth edition of the NAIA Women's Basketball Division II "Top 25" rankings.

Black Hills State moved up one spot to No. 5. The Yellow Jackets are currently on an ten-game winning streak. Jamestown remained to No. 10.

Minot State stayed at No. 13. The Beavers will travel to Black Hills State Friday night in a battle of NAIA "Top 25" teams.

Dickinson State received votes to the national poll.

The final poll will be released on Feb. 22nd. It will be used to determine the at-large bids for the NAIA National Tournament in March.

#### DAC POSTSEASON TOURNAMENT BEGINS WEDNESDAY:

The DAC Women's Basketball Postseason Tournament will begin on Wednesday, Feb. 24th. The pairings will be announced after the completion of Feb. 20th games.

FOR THE RECORD: Dakota State is 10-15 overall and 4-8 in the DAC Conference. Valley City State is 14-12 overall and 5-7 in the conference. Jamestown is 20-6 and 9-3 in the DAC.

The Trojans are seventh in the DAC standings, one game behind SD School of Mines and Valley City State (both teams with 5-7 DAC record). DSU have a tiebreaker over the Hardrockers if both teams finished with identical records after Feb. 20th. Jamestown is one game behind DAC's leader Black Hills State.

LAST WEEKEND: The Trojans went 2-1 in their final three home games at the DSU Fieldhouse. DSU lost to the Yellow Jackets 85-75 on Feb. 12th. The Trojans rallied in the second half and closing minutes over SD School of Mines 88-82 on Feb. 13th. DSU won the final home regular season game on Feb. 16th over Trinity Bible, 95-32. It was the most points for the Trojans this season.

Jamestown survived Valley City State's second-half surge on Feb. 10th in Jamestown. The Jimmies held a 36-25 halftime lead and held on for a 62-59 win in Jamestown, N.D.

Joe Reints is in his second year with the Trojan women's basketball program. He comes to Dakota State University from Lambuth University in Jackson, Tenn., where he served as head coach of the Lady Eagles, an NAIA Division I school, for three years. The Lady Eagles earned the 2007 NAIA Division I National Championship. Coach Reints' career record at Lambuth University was 69-33 and his team maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.03.



From 2003-2005, Reints served as Assistant Women's Basketball Coach for Texas State University. He has additional coaching experience with Mount Marty College and Northern State University. Reints graduated from South Dakota State University with a Bachelor of Science in History and from Northern State University with a Master's in Health, Physical Education, and Coaching.

Reints is originally from Willow Lake, S.D. In addition to his coaching duties, Reints serves as assistant to the athletic director.

Prior coming to Dakota State University, Ersland served as an assistant at Luther College (Decorah, Iowa), Rose Hulman Institute of Technology (Terre Haute, Ind.) and was a student assistant manager at the University of Wyoming.

In addition, he began his coaching career on the junior and senior high school levels in Waterloo, Iowa.

Ersland is involved heavily in every aspect of the women's basketball program and his primary focuses are recruiting, academic supervision and coordinating/scheduling summer team camps. He has over ten years of experience coaching and teaching the game of basketball on all levels and has worked summer camps across the country, including Snow Valley Basketball School in Iowa, University of Tennessee Lady Vols, South Dakota State University, Drake University, University of Wyoming and Northern State University.

Ersland, a graduate of Columbus High School in Waterloo, Iowa, earned his bachelor's degree in Recreation and Sports Management and his master's degree in Physical Education/Coaching from Indiana State University. In his personal time, he enjoys cheering on the Boston Celtics and Chicago Bears, reading, playing fantasy football/basketball and spending time with his family and friends.

In addition to coaching responsibilities, Ersland serves as the Resident Director of the Zimmerman Hall at Dakota State University.

**Game Notes**

**DAKOTA STATE-VALLEY CITY STATE MATCHUP:** Dakota State won the first meeting from Valley City State on Jan. 26th at the DSU Fieldhouse. Alyssa Kirk hit a game-winning 3-pointer with 16 seconds to go and Donna Lavea added a free-throw to defeat the Vikings 77-75.

The Trojans raced to a 21-8 lead with 11:54 left before intermission. DSU held a 41-34 halftime advantage. Valley City State rallied back in the second half and took a 65-61 lead with 8:13 left in the game. Each team alternated or overtook the lead in the closing minutes. The Vikings failed an opportunity to tie or take the lead with less than 10 seconds to go.

Donna Lavea leads the Trojans in three different categories. She averages 13.8 points per game and shoots 55 percent from the field (11th in the nation). Lavea leads the team in rebounds with 7.4 average. She ranks 40th in the nation in total blocks with 34 (1.4 average). Katie Bourk ranks 39th in the nation in assists per game (4.0). She ranks 29th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (40.4). Ellesse Washington leads the team in steals with 36 (1.4 average). Alyssa Kirk ranks 21st in the nation in 3-point field goal made per game (2.4). As a team, Dakota State ranks 22nd in the nation in 3-point field goal made per game (7.4), 28th in 3-point field goals made (185), 31st in field goal percentage (42.1), 36th in assists per game (14.2), 45th in scoring offense (69.7) and 45th in 3-point field goal percentage (33.1).

For Valley City State, Abby Rittenhouse leads the team in scoring with 13.8 points per game. She leads the team in rebounding with 6.4 per game. Rittenhouse ranks 6th in the nation in free-throw percentage (86.1). Caitlyn Wojahn records 93 assists (3.6 per game) and 94 steals (3.6 per game). She ranks 10th in total steals and 46th in 3-point field goal made per game (2.1). Heidi Larson records 16 blocks this season. As a team, the Vikings ranks 19th in total rebounds per game (34.0), 26th in scoring defense per game (60.5), 29th in free-throw percentage (71.8) and 36th in steals per game (11.1).

**DAKOTA STATE-JAMESTOWN MATCHUP:** After a sluggish first half by both teams, Jamestown outscored the Trojans 44-32 in the second half for Jimmie's 66-52 victory in Madison, S.D. on Jan. 22nd. The Jimmies led 22-20 at halftime.

The Trojans tied the game three times in the early second-half at 22, 25 and 27. Jamestown went on an 18-7 run to take a 45-34 lead with 11:35 left to go in regulation. DSU cut the deficit to seven points (58-51) with less than three minutes to go, but could not get any closer. The Jimmies closed the game with an 8-1 run to secure the victory.

Giuli Varrino leads Jamestown in scoring and rebounding categories. She averages 12.3 points per game and shoots 50.6 percent from the field. Varrino records 171 rebounds this season (6.6 average) and leads the team in steals with 61 (2.4 average). Kelli Schuneman records 114 total assists this season (4.4 average). She ranks 17th in the nation in assist/turnover ratio (1.676), 19th in free-throw percentage (82.6), 20th in total assists and 23rd in assists per game. Allison Epping leads the team in blocked shots with 27. As a team, Jamestown ranks 10th in total rebounds defense (32.3), 14th in assist/turnover ratio (0.903), 17th in total rebound margin (+6.7), 19th in scoring margin (+12.0), 19th in field goal percentage (43.2) and 22nd in scoring offense (73.0).
